# **From Pastor Logan**

Faith...what a peculiar word. If we look it up in the dictionary, we find descriptions like confidence, complete, trust, strong, and belief. There are some powerful illustrations for this five-letter word. Faith is a word that I want us to lean on this year, really make our go to. Thomas Merton, a Trappist Monk once wrote "First of all, faith is not an emotion, not a feeling. It's not a blind subconscious urge toward something vaguely supernatural. It is not simply an elemental need in man's spirit. It is not a feeling that God exists. It is not a conviction that one is somehow saved or "justified" for no special reason expect that one happens to feel that way. It is not something entirely interior and subjective, with no reference to any external motive. It is not just "soul force". Faith is first of all an intellectual assent. It perfects the mind; it does not destroy it. It puts the intellect in possession of truth which reason cannot grasp by itself. It gives us certitude concerning God... Ultimately faith is the only key to the universe. The final meaning of human existence, and the answers to questions on which all of our happiness depends cannot be reached in any other way." (New Seed of Contemplation, 1962). Faith is the key! Having faith means that we are confident, complete, strong, and trusting in God. I pray that we reflect on the words from Thomas Merton as we enter into the second month of this new year. We have many days ahead and leaning into our faith and trust in God will be vital.




